HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

St. George's International School also provides a High School Diploma Programme (HSDP) for students aiming primarily for further education in US Colleges and not wishing to take the International Baccalaureate. St. George's International School continues to offer the British IGCSE programme, through Cambridge International Examinations, usually taken in late spring of Year 11.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate and receive a diploma, a student must have fulfilled the following requirements:

1. Successful completion of Years 10 to 13, i.e., U.S. grades 9, 10, 11, 12, or their equivalent in the student's home country, assuming the entire last year is completed at St. George's International School.
2. Minimum age of 17 attained before date of graduation.
3. Minimum of 26 credits attained in academic work. The 26 credits must include: English 4, Mathematics 3, Science 2, Foreign language 2, Social Science 2, ICT 2.
4. Physical education is required for each year of attendance, though no credits are awarded.
5. Minimum score of 6/9 in IELTS or Cambridge Advanced Certificate of English.
